

Introduction

Under the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006, training is mandatory for anyone liable to be exposed to asbestos fibres at work.

Aim

To provide delegates with a clear understanding of the hazards from asbestos-containing materials (ACMs) and an overview of the applicable legislation.

Outcomes

Delegates will be able to:

- Appreciate how ACMs can be disturbed and the likely legal and business implications
- Identify where such ACMs are likely to exist within buildings and how to deal with them.
- Understand the hazards from the different types of asbestos fibres, their means of entry to the body diseases associated with asbestos and their outcomes
- Recognise emergency/hazardous situations and how to risk assess and prioritise them.
- Confidently cope with most asbestos hazards
