Delegates will be able to understand:

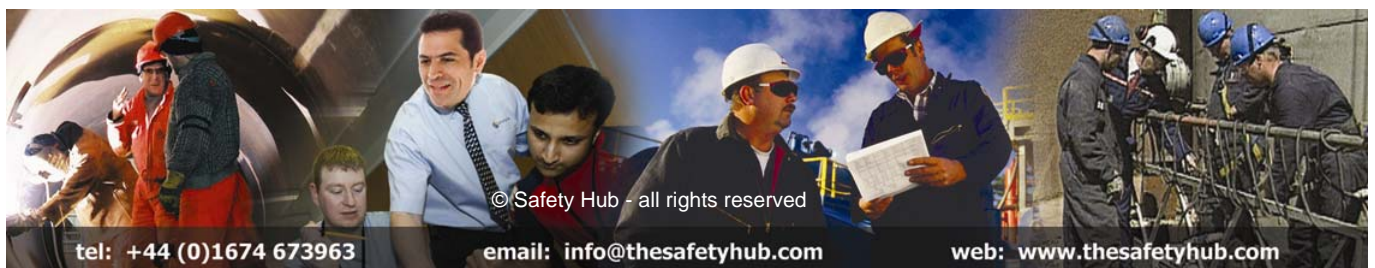
- The necessity for controlling work effectively
