

Introduction

The Dangerous Goods Safety Adviser (DGSA) course focuses on training supervisors and managers of organisations with dangerous goods by road shipments to be Dangerous Goods Safety Advisers as required by the Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment 2009 and ADR 2009 Regulations.

Aim

To prepare prospective DGSAs for the SQA examinations and their work as a DGSA.

Outcomes

Delegates will be able to:

- Monitor compliance with the rules governing the transport of dangerous goods
- Advise their organisation on the transport of dangerous goods
- Prepare the annual report to the organisation on the activities concerning dangerous goods
- Monitor the practices and procedures relating to the activities of the organisation concerning the transport of dangerous goods

Suitable for: Supervisors or managers responsible for performing the DGSA function.
