

### **Introduction**

The course provides drivers with the instruction required by the Department of Transport to pass the Scottish Qualifications Authority examinations in order to obtain their Vocational Training Certificate (VTC) - commonly known as the ADR Licence. This course, the examinations and the tutor are regulated by the Department for Transport and Scottish Qualifications Authority

### **Aim**

To give drivers of dangerous goods theoretical and practical training in the basic regulations governing the carriage of dangerous goods by road, the classes of dangerous goods, emergency response, first aid, fire fighting, operational procedures, handling, loading, unloading, and equipment.

### **Outcomes**

Successful completion of the course and SQA examinations leads to the driver being issued with a VTC (ADR Licence).

Passing selected additional modules enables drivers to extend the scope of their ADR to cover additional classes of dangerous goods

Attendance on an ADR training course may be taken into account when calculating a driver's hours.

**Suitable for:** Drivers requiring to obtain the ADR Licence in order to be qualified to drive dangerous goods; drivers requiring to extend their ADR to cover additional classes of dangerous goods; drivers requiring refresher training.

**Prior Knowledge/training:** Depends on scope of ADR required

**Course Duration:** Up to 7 days, depending how many modules are taken

**Numbers:** Minimum 4, maximum 10
