Aim

To provide the training required by the IMDG Code 2008 for personnel involved in dangerous goods operations.

Delegates will be able to:

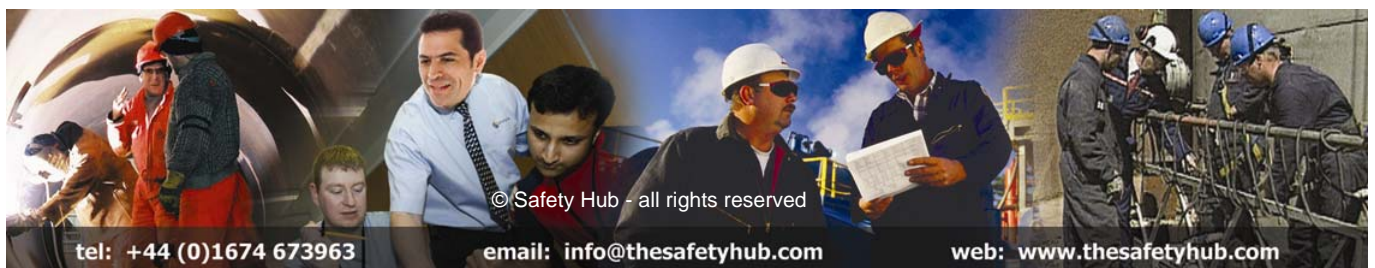
- Understand and apply the IMDG Dangerous Goods Regulations

- Correctly pack dangerous goods in the appropriate packaging
- Mark and label packages
- Document shipments
