

Introduction

Organisations that interact with marine operations have a duty to ensure their personnel have a thorough understanding of the specialist nature of working with vessels and the hazards and risks involved in these operations. This course is designed to provide information and guidance to all personnel who are likely to be involved with marine operations in order to enhance the safety and efficiency of these operations.

Aim

To provide delegates with the knowledge and skills to identify and recognise potential hazards and to recognise safe and unsafe practice during marine operations.

Outcomes

Delegates will gain understanding of:

- Roles of key personnel
- Vessel types
- Bulk loading operations
- Dangerous goods
- Overboard discharges
- Planning communication and contingency
- Relevant standards, procedures and guidelines

Suitable for: All personnel involved in marine operations, e.g. deck crew, rigging crew, drill crew, deck foreman, materials coordinator, control room operator

Prior Knowledge/training: Offshore operations and conditions experience advantageous but not essential
