

Introduction

Correct and proper training of staff and maintenance of good standards of equipment and working areas is a legal requirement of all employers, regardless of company size or nature of the business.

Aim

To provide delegates with an introduction to the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 and how they apply to their work place. To provide the knowledge and skills to perform PUWER assessments within their employer's safety management system.

- Carry out inspections and make maintenance reports
- Utilise control and control systems
- Apply the regulations in terms of information, instruction and training
- Recognise specific hazards
