

## **Introduction**

The Management of Health & Safety at Work Regulations 1999 requires an employer to make a suitable and sufficient assessment of the risks to workers and others who may be affected by their undertakings.

## **Aim**

To provide delegates with sufficient knowledge of the principles, procedures and legislation to enable them to carry out effective task based risk assessments in the work place.

- Understand the moral and business benefits of effective and practical risk assessments
- Outline the legal requirements for the assessment of risk at work
- Understand the key terms Hazard, Hazard Effect, Risk, Probability, Control, ALARP
- Identify hazards in the workplace
- Evaluate levels of risk
- Identify appropriate control measures based on the hierarchy of control
- Implement management action plans arising from the assessment process
